Introductory.

It is an interesting fact that in the selection of Great Bible Chapters no less than five were chosen from the Gospel according to John.

John I & II. We have considered.

In dealing with XIV & XV difficulties are created by the fact that neither is complete; XIV needs XIII; and XV is linked to XVI.

In dealing with XIV - He must refer to XIII.

The story there concludes with Peter's question; -
"Lord - Whither goest thou?"

Our Lord's reply runs over to XIV. 4.

Then - three other disciples spoke in turn; & He replied to each.

Nevertheless, there is a sense in which XIV is complete.
