Introductory.

Jesus sits as King, unfolding the principles and laws of His Kingdom.

In these opening sentences, He reveals the character and genius of the Kingdom of heaven.

Human Ideas.

Race Power.
military Prowess.
Outward Splendour.

Himself & His teaching combine to ignore, and so deny these conceptions.

Scheme.

A. A revelation of general principles.

B. Particular revelation of character.

A. General Principles.

i. "Blessed."

That reveals God's will for man, and so reveals the purpose of the King, and the atmosphere of the Kingdom.

The word (makarios) is translated in the A.V. "Blessed" 43 times, and "Happy" 6.

ii. "Blessed are"

Happiness depends on being, not on doing or having.

iii. "Blessed are --- for."

Character creates conditions which result in happiness. E.G. "Blessed are the pure in heart,..."

The character of heart purity results in the vision of God, which is happiness.

So the happiness of the Kingdom is a natural sequence rather than an arbitrary reward.
